What is Video Game?

A VIDEO GAME IS AN ELECTRONIC GAME THAT INVOLVES INTERACTION WITH A USER INTERFACE OR INPUT DEVICE – SUCH AS A JOYSTICK, CONTROLLER, KEYBOARD, OR MOTION SENSING DEVICE – TO GENERATE VISUAL FEEDBACK FOR A PLAYER.

HISTORY OF VIDEO GAMES

- **1961** - Spacewar, the world's first interactive computer game, is created for the Digital PDP-1 mainframe computer at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT).
- **1967** - Ralph Baer designs the "Brown Box" which can play simple video games on a standard television set (released as the Magnavox Odyssey in 1972).
- **1971** - Nolan Bushnell, founder of Atari, releases the first video arcade game, Computer Space.
- **1972** - Atari engineer Al Alcorn creates the simple tennis-style arcade game Pong, the first commercially successful video game.
- **1975** - Sears releases an Atari-built home Pong console.
- **1977** - Atari releases its first cartridge-based video game console, the Video Computer System (later called the Atari 2600).

HISTORY OF VIDEO GAMES

- **1978** - Taito releases Space Invaders, and the game's popularity causes a shortage of 100 Yen coins in Japan.
- **1980** - Activision, formed by disgruntled Atari programmers, becomes the world's first third-party video game publisher. Namco releases Pac-Man and Nintendo unveil the first Game & Watch units.
- **1982** - Game publisher Electronic Arts founded by Trip Hawkins.
- **1983** - The Commodore 64 is released, a powerful home computer/gaming system for a low price. In Japan, Nintendo launch the Famicom (and Super Mario Bros) which is released two years later in the West as the Nintendo Entertainment System.
- **1985** - Russian programmer Alex Pajitnov develops Tetris.
- **1986** - Sega introduces the Master System.
- **1987** - Will Wright releases "software toy" SimCity.
- **1989** - Nintendo releases the handheld Game Boy console.
- **1991** - Strategy game Civilization released by Microprose, Street Fighter II released by Capcom.
- **1993** - 3D shooter Doom released by id Software, while Myst encourages many PC owners to buy CD-ROM drives
- **1994** - Sony enters the video game business with the PlayStation console.

FIRST GAMING CONSOLE

The Odyssey was manufactured by **Magnavox** and released in North America in September of 1972. It stands as the very first home video game console. The system was developed by Ralph Baer, a German-American engineer who created the **ping-pong** style gameplay that the Odyssey offered.

TECHNOLOGY

- As technology in 3-D animation got advanced, Video games got advanced too.
- 3D animations started to render in real time with latest technology as Rasterization, Real time ray tracing in games.
- AI upscaling by Nvidia known as Deep learning super sampling (DLSS) use AI tensor cores to upscale a lower resolution image to higher resolution.
